Little Learners is a class for the youngest learners at Co-op. This will be a free-formed class versus a structured, sit down class. All of the activities will involve use of the five senses. Children use their senses to explore and try to make sense of the world around them. They do this by touching, tasting, smelling, seeing, moving and hearing. Sensory play helps language development, cognitive growth, fine motor skills and gross motor skills, problem solving skills and social interactions. We will have some messy, sensory play at some of our stations, but prior warning will be given.
