#### **Theatre and Acting**

Facilitator: Midland Community Theatre

<u>Target Ages</u>: Group 1) **8-9 year olds**; and Group 2) **10-12 year olds** 

<u>Cost</u>: \$20 per student. Commit to the four-week class. (This cost is over 70% off our regular online Theatre School class price at MCT and is intended as an introductory offer)

<u>Minimum/Maximum enrollment per class</u>: 6-8 students



Class Description: This introductory theatre arts class provided by Midland Community Theatre Education Department will focus on basic theatre and acting skills such as pantomime, storytelling, and acting games. Novice as well as veteran actors can enjoy these activities as they collaborate with their peers. Our goal beyond developing skills in acting is to help students explore their social interaction, leadership skills and creativity - tools that assist students in all areas of education and life.

NOTES: All students still have the option to participate in regularly scheduled classes at MCT, which meet later in the day. MCT Theatre School classes meet for K-6 grade meet from 4:15 to 5:15 pm one day a week (day determined by age/grade level). Since there is no offering here for older students, we recommend Centerstage class for 7-12 graders which meets on Mondays from 5:30 to 7:00 beginning February 1st.
